1758 – During the French and Indian War, the British captured Fort Duquesne. Fort Pitt was built nearby and grew into modern Pittsburgh.

1867 – Alfred Nobel patented dynamite. The name is from the Greek *dýnamis*, meaning “power.”

1949 – “Rudolph, the Red-Nosed Reindeer,” performed by Gene Autry, appeared on the music charts for the first time. The song was written by Johnny Marks.

2014 – After scoring three goals in a match against Apoel Nicosia, Lionel Messi became the all-time top scorer in the Champions League.

“**Joltin’**” **Joe DiMaggio** (1914–1999) is one of the greatest Major League Baseball players of all time. He played center field for the New York Yankees for all 13 years of his career. DiMaggio won the Most Valuable Player Award three times



and led the Yankees to nine World Series wins. He retired in 1951 with 361 home runs, and his extraordinary record of having a 56-game

hitting streak still stands today. DiMaggio was briefly married to icon Marilyn Monroe and had one son from a previous marriage to actress Dorothy Arnold.
