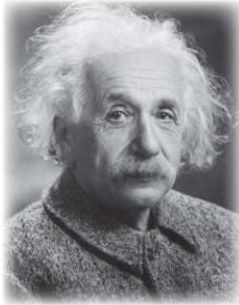

## On This Date

**1794** – The British whaler *Butterworth* became the first European ship to sail into a Hawaiian harbor. Captain William Brown named the harbor *Fair Haven*.

**1846** – The word *anesthesia* was coined by Dr. Oliver Wendell Holmes in a letter to William Morton, the dentist who gave the first public demonstration of ether.

**1905** – Albert Einstein’s paper “Does the Inertia of a Body Depend Upon Its Energy Content?” was published. His paper revealed the relationship between energy and mass, leading to the formula  $E = mc^2$ .

**Hetty Green** (1834–1916) was a savvy American businesswoman and financier who excelled in what was then a man’s realm. Known as “the richest woman in America” and the “witch of Wall Street,” her perceived miserliness was fodder for the tabloids.



Green came from a wealthy whaling family and used her inheritance to make astute investments of her own. She agreed to marry her husband on the condition that their finances remained separate and that he did not use her reputation to conduct his own business. Green outlived her husband, and her fortune was divided between her two children.
