1802 – President Thomas Jefferson signed legislation establishing the U.S. Military Academy at West Point. Currently, about 1,000 graduates are commissioned as U.S. Army officers every year.

1844 – A patent for "a new and improved harpoon for the destruction and taking of whales" was issued to Albert Moore. An explosive device was contained in the tip of the harpoon.

1850 – Nathaniel Hawthorne's *The Scarlet Letter* was published. It was widely read and discussed to an extent not often experienced in America until that time.

Henry "Henny" Youngman (1906–1998) was a famous stand-up comedian known as the "King of the One-Liners." Born in London and raised in New York City, Youngman got his start as a performing violinist who told jokes in between songs, but soon the jokes became the main attraction. Youngman was known for his rapid-fire delivery of quick quips,



including "Take my wife—please!" and "A doctor gave his patient six months to live, but he couldn't pay his bill, so he gave him another

six months." He performed for an astonishing 70 years before passing away in 1998 at age 91.
