Anne Inez McCaffrey (1926–2011) was an acclaimed American Irish science-fiction and fantasy writer who was born in Cambridge, Massachusetts. She is best known for the extensive *Dragonriders of*



Pern series, which includes 24 novels. The groundbreaking author was the first woman writer to win a Hugo Award

for fiction (*Weyr Search*, 1968) and a Nebula Award (*Dragonrider*, 1969). McCaffrey was inducted into the Science Fiction Hall of Fame in 2006 and honored by the Science Fiction and Fantasy Writers of America as the organization's 22nd Grand Master.
