## Only Human

Researchers at the Georgia Institute of Technology have designed a tiny microchip, smaller than a ladybug, that can monitor heart and lung functions. The chip is designed to ignore noises like rustling clothes while detecting vibrations that come from inside the body, such as the heartbeat and sounds from inside the lungs. The signals recorded by the chip escape monitoring by most medical technologies, offering a diagnostic breakthrough. When the chip registers an anomaly, it also signals to its wearer that it is time for a checkup with a doctor.
