Wardell Edwin Bond (1903–1960), who went by the name Ward Bond professionally, was a prolific American character actor from Benkelman, Nebraska. Bond acted in over 200 films, including starring as Bert the Cop in *It’s a Wonderful Life*. Some of his other films include *Bringing Up Baby*, *The Maltese*



Falcon, *Joan of Arc*, *Gone with the Wind*, and *Rio Bravo*.

He also appeared in 23 movies with John Wayne and shared a lifelong friendship with the screen icon, who once accidentally shot him during a hunting trip. Bond also starred in the TV series *Wagon Train*.
