Walt "Clyde" Frazier, born in 1945, is a legendary American NBA star who played point guard for the New York Knicks, leading them to victory in two NBA Championships in 1970 and in 1973. Frazier retired in 1979 and now works as a broadcast analyst for Knicks games. He is known for his stylish, colorful suits and turns of phrase. He was named to the NBA 75th Anniversary Team in

2021, recognized as one of the best NBA players in history. Frazier was inducted into the Naismith Memorial Basketball



Hall of Fame as both a player in 1987 and as a broadcaster in 2022.
