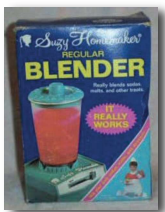

The line included the Budget Blender, Dishwasher-Sink, Hair Dryer, High-Speed Mixer, Refrigerator, Super Oven, Washing Machine, and others. The line represented a domestic ideal for girls as suburban homemakers.

Centennial Memories

On this day 100 years ago, the controversial yet charismatic Mexican revolutionary named Pancho Villa surrendered. The Mexican Revolution began in 1910 when Francisco Madero challenged the legitimacy of President Porfirio Díaz. Villa became one of Madero's most vital revolutionary leaders.
