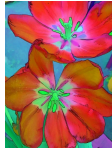


Heads UP New Shop Hours

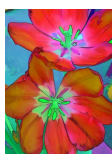

Special Class Fee \$15

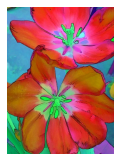
Free pattern and you will use worsted weight

A personal note from Debbi:

I recently did some research on knit shop class fees at shops around the country. I was shocked when I saw the teaching fees for simple projects and classes for beginners. Other knit shops are charging as much as \$45 - \$65 or more (supplies not included) for classes and workshops. Simple "Fix its" are NOT free. Check it out for yourself. Many shops do not even have space for you

to sit and stitch unless you are paying for a class. There is no “open table” availability.

At Sin City Knit Shop the teachers take the cut in class fees to teach you. We all want you to learn techniques & new stitches for your knitting and crocheting skills. If you are serious about growing with the art of knitting and crocheting, please take advantage of scheduled classes. It is not fair to the teachers or the students paying for the class when you don't take the class and pop in for help with that project.

If you come in for a quick Fix it (15 minutes or less) from an employee or teacher, please consider tipping them a few bucks for their time. If you need more help (more than 15 minutes) you MUST schedule time to get that help.

We all consider Sin City Knit Shop our home and everyone is family. We love that! Our visitors always comment that they wished their knit shop was more like us.
