The convention bid package was recently updated in October which should help with setting up the convention. PID Debra asked if there would be expectations that 5M2 members would be part of the planning committee. Right now the expectation would be that the current sitting DGs would be most of the committee. 50¢ of dues paid each year goes into a pool for the Multiple Convention. The contracts that are in place have a cut off date and a clause that we are not liable for the amount of rooms not used. Legal needs to check the contracts prior to signing. MC Unanimously.
