

Camper Supply Checklist

To ensure a safe and fun time, each camper needs to bring the following items to camp each day.

Appropriate outdoor clothing (including warm layers for cooler days)

□ Shoes appropriate for outdoor recreation

A reusable water bottle (one will be provided on the first day of camp!)

Any prescription medications needed while at camp

A positive attitude, ready to have fun!

Campers are asked **NOT** to bring any of the following items.

- X Toys. Campers will have a full day of fun and engaging activities; we want to prevent any distractions. Plus, we don't want those favorite toys to get lost.
- X Electronic devises, including cell phones, music players, etc. We understand that parents may want to communicate with their child for pick-up or emergency situations. Parents are invited to call the camp phone during the day. Campers will be able to pick up their devices starting at 3:15 PM each day.
- X Weapons or perceived weapons of any kind. This includes toy weapons.
- X Any other items that may cause distractions or contribute to a negative environment.

If any of these (or similar) items are brought to camp, staff will hold the item(s) for the day and the camper/parent/guardian will be responsible to pick it up at check-out.
