Camper Behavior Guidelines are enforced for the benefit of all campers' safety and success while at JA Biz Camp Alaska. All campers must adhere to the Camper Behavior Guidelines.

If a camper is unable to follow the Behavior Guidelines, the following consequences will be enforced:

- 1. A warning
- 2. A break or separation from the challenge or problem, where the camper (with help from camp staff) will develop a plan on how to change behavior
- 3. A call to parent/guardian informing them of the behavior
- 4. Campers who continuously break behavior guidelines may be asked to leave for the day. Parents/Guardians will be required to pick up their child immediately.
- 5. Campers who are unable to uphold camp behavior guidelines over the course of more than one day may be asked to not return to camp in the following days.
