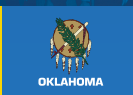

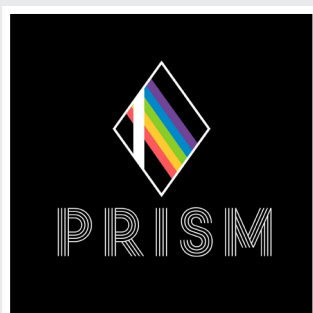

SOUTHWESTERN DISTRICT HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

The Southwestern District's Hall of Fame was organized and initiated in 1986-1987 to recognize those SWD barbershoppers who have made exceptional, long-standing, unselfish and dedicated contributions to the Chapter, the District, and the Society. This award exists to extol the virtues of such excellence and to focus pride on these achievements and accomplishments.

SWD Hall of Fame inductees have been a member of the district for not less than 10 years and of the Society not less than 15 years. Contributions may have been in areas of administration or music, and are often both. Levels include Chapter, Division, District and Society, and contributions may be in the nature of service and activities which have added to the overall well-being of the District and furtherance of our hobby.

The service and activities could be in the areas of quartetting, coaching, chorus directing, judging, composing, arranging, administrating, teaching, writing, promoting and others, and generally in some combination of these.

2024 INDUCTEE - MARK CLARK



Mark Clark has served the membership of the Southwestern District in many ways in his 51 years as a member of the Barbershop Harmony Society.

At the Society level Mark served on the Society Marketing committee.

Mark's other Society accomplishments include:

- Recruited over 40 new members for the Society, SWD, and Chapters!
- Certified Director
- Featured in Harmonizer for recruiting and retention of members

At the chapter level, Mark has held every office in his chapters of Abilene and San Angelo. He has also been the Music Director of Twin Mountain Chordsmen for 34 years! As a quarteter Mark has sung various parts in over 10 quartets; one with his Dad and brother placing 4th at SWD Contest (Jubilee).

Mark has also served in various duties at the district level:

- VP – Marketing (2 separate terms)
- VP – Membership
- SWD District Area Councilor/chapter support representative
- SWD Standing Ovation Previewer/Coach
- SWD Harmony Ranch Instructed site reading classes and Coached quartets numerous times
- DYNAMO (Develop Your Numbers And Musical Organization) Coach

Mark had also been a coach for many quartets throughout his 51 years.

As SWD VP – Membership, he tracked the membership during COVID for each chapter individually and for the district as a whole. This was extremely valuable to the SWD President in order to stay connected with chapters. He also worked with other SWD Board members to contact chapters to make sure they were keeping in touch with their members for the best retention.

Mark has distinguished himself in his service at the Chapter, District, and society levels.

SWD HALL OF FAME

2024 INDUCTEE - MIKE THOMPSON



Mike Thompson joined the Barbershop Harmony Society in July 1996. He enjoys singing in quartets and in his chapters. He has also volunteered time as a chapter officer many times. He's also a certified Administrative Judge.

Mike has assisted 5 different SWD DRCJ's starting in 2013. He has been the primary contact for quartets entering into SWD

Spring and Fall contests. Verifying quartet and quartet members are qualified to enter a contest. Verifying they have at least the right number of songs in their Repertory, and other duties to help the DRCJ get everything ready for district contests.

Additionally, when the judges come to the Southwestern District contests, they are provided a room, of course, but also their meals. The SWD would take the judges to a restaurant away from the venue or take them down to the restaurant in the hotel as well as provide some type of box meal or meal allowance at the hotel restaurant. As you can imagine that can be really costly.

10 years ago, Mike came up with an idea. What if we just cook meals for the judges. Some of us might decide to just bring in donuts, pizza, and maybe some barbecue and leave it at that. Not this guy. His idea was to create a great breakfast, lunch, dinner and late-night snacks cooked and served in one room dedicated for the judges, each day of the contest. He also decided to provide snacks during intermissions along with various drinks, such as coffee, tea, soft drinks and water at the ready for the judges.

Besides the huge financial savings, it gave the judges the flexibility to grab a bite to eat and have discussions with other judges in a safe space. They could share meals with each other or in groups that may be having discussions. The judges knew they could get what they wanted and continue with their duties. This also allowed the judges some significant downtime during the contest weekend, which is typically packed with other things to do. He bought the cooking and serving equipment that he needed out of his own pocket.

His dedication to the judges in this self-designed duty spread across the contest judging community! His personal service was something that the judges looked forward to experiencing by coming to the Southwestern District.

Thanks to him the Southwestern District saved thousands of dollars in his service to the judges!

DETERMINING RELATIVE RANK

•Musicality

Musicality is defined as the song and arrangement, as performed. The Musicality Category judges the arranger's skill and the performer's musicianship in bringing the mood or the story of the song to life, and the sustainability of the material to the Barbershop style.

•Performance

These judges evaluate how effectively a performer brings the song to life. They judge the entertainment value of the performance - the art of the performance.

•Singing

In the Singing Category, artistic singing in the Barbershop style is judged - listening holistically for ringing in-tune voices that use a free, beautiful and rich vocal quality, which is wonderfully unified and vocally expressive.

Each judge may award up to 100 points per song.

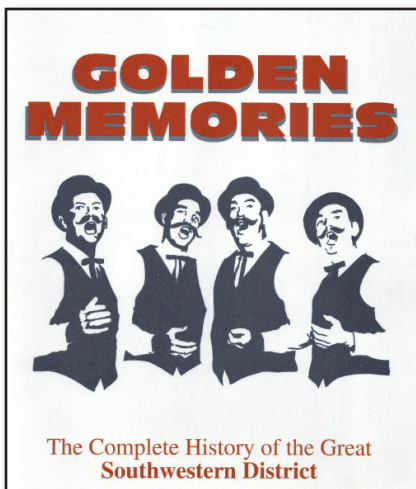

Published in 1996, Golden Memories is more than 450 pages starting with the Barbershop Harmony Society's beginnings in 1938 at Tulsa, Oklahoma (known then as the Society for the Preservation and Encouragement of Barbershop Quartet Singing in America - S.P.E.B.S.Q.S.A.), the SWD's beginnings in 1949, pioneers of the SWD, chapter growth, SWD presidents and administration, contests and conventions, quartets, choruses and significant milestones.

We must preserve and extend this valuable piece of SWD history, but we need your help!
