SWD Coaching for Choruses & Coaching Guild


Coaching

A network of support for choruses to receive coaching from individuals who live within the district at no cost to the chapter. Coaching is available to all chapters with basic travel expenses paid by the district. Guild Coaches work with choruses to improve and expand their musical knowledge and performance abilities. Published in 1996, Golden Memories is more than 450 pages starting with the Barbershop Harmony Society's beginnings in 1938 at Tulsa, Oklahoma (known then as the Society for the Preservation and Encouragement of Barbershop Quartet Singing in America - S.P.E.B.S.Q.S.A.), the SWD's beginnings in 1949, pioneers of the SWD, chapter growth, SWD presidents and administration, contests and conventions, quartets, choruses and significant milestones.

We must preserve and extend this valuable piece of SWD history, but we need your help!

We announced this project a few months ago and asked you to send photos and recordings so we could make the book interactive and many of you have responded! You'll find a few links to recordings throughout the book, but we've only scratched the surface.

2024 - HARMONY UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS FROM THE SOUTHWESTERN DISTRICT

Harmony University 2024 is in Denver, Colorado, at the University of Denver from July 28 - August 4 and will offer the opportunity to hone musical, vocal, performance, director, arranging, teaching, and coaching skills. Attendees can also earn Graduate or CEU credits, and professional development hours.

SWD Scholarship to attend HU includes:

- instruction
- •food (3 meals a day and ice cream each night)
- •room
- activities
- shows
- •TBD shuttle pickup to/from Denver airport to University of Denver.

Scholarships do not cover individual transportation to/from Denver, Colorado.

Applications are reviewed and will be awarded to applicants prior to the closing of registration. If you are a scholarship recipient for 2024, the SWD VP of Music & SWD Treasurer will be communicating with

HU staff so that your registration can be completed with the scholarship applied.

SWD offers Half or Full Scholarships to attend Harmony University, with preference given to first-time attendees. These scholarships are need-based and cover room, board, and tuition. However a \$50 service fee must be paid by the applicant to create and schedule your classes in the SCHED app/website. If you receive a scholarship, you'll get an email with further instructions on how to register.

If you are a Director, Assistant Director, Musical/ Visual Leader, Arranger or a Music Educator, note that there are specific tracks (classes) that align with your field that are the recommended courses from the Deans for your discipline.
