



DETERMINING RELATIVE RANK

Musicality

Music is defined as the song and arrangement, as performed. The Musicality Category judges the arranger's skill and the performer's musicianship in bringing the mood or the story of the song to life, and the sustainability of the material to the Barbershop style.


Performance

These judges evaluate how effectively a performer brings the song to life. They judge the entertainment value of the performance - the art of the performance.

Singing

In the Singing Category, artistic singing in the Barbershop style is judged - listening holistically for ringing in-tune voices that use a free, beautiful and rich vocal quality, which is wonderfully unified and vocally expressive.

Each judge may award up to 100 points per category, per song.

2025 - HARMONY UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIPS FROM THE SOUTHWESTERN DISTRICT

Harmony University 2025 is in Denver, Colorado, at the University of Denver from July 27 - August 3 and offers the opportunity to hone musical, vocal, performance, director, arranging, teaching, and coaching skills. Attendees can earn Graduate or CEU credits, and professional development hours.

Scan the QR code on the next page for the registration form and for more specific information about HU and what will be offered in 2025.

The SWD Scholarship to attend HU includes:

- instruction
- •food (3 meals a day and ice cream each night)
- •room
- activities
- shows
- •TBD shuttle pickup to/from Denver airport to University of Denver.
- Scholarships do not cover individual transportation to/from Denver, Colorado.

Applications are reviewed and will be awarded to applicants prior to the closing of registration. If you are a scholarship recipient for 2025, the SWD VP of Music & SWD Treasurer will be communicating with HU staff so that your registration can be completed with the scholarship applied.

SWD offers Half or Full Scholarships to attend Harmony University, with preference given to first-time attendees. These scholarships are need-based and cover room, board, and tuition. However **a \$50 service fee** must be paid by the applicant to create and schedule your classes in the SCHED app/website. If you receive a scholarship, you'll get an email with further instructions on how to register.

If you are a Director, Assistant Director, Musical/ Visual Leader, Arranger or a Music Educator, note that there are specific tracks (classes) that align with your field that are the recommended courses from the Deans for your discipline.

SWD members who are also on HU Faculty include Allen Otto, Peter Cunningham, and Anthony Bartholomew. Don't hesitate to reach out to your fellow district members for any advice and recommendations on HU and creating a high-quality experience.
