With the translation approval of the Tk'emlups te Secwepemc First Nation, I have designed a Every Child Matters Coin.

Between 1867 and 1996, the Canadian state abducted more than 150,000 Indigenous children from their parents and forced them into these schools as part of a campaign of forced assimilation. Thousands were subject to physical, emotional and sexual abuse. According to the official register, 3,213 died.

My vision is to have a Coin sold for each of the missing Indigenous children and to place a Every Child Matters Coin in the hands of a child to carry the memory of an Indigenous child with them.

Help build a healing legacy for the survivors of the Residential School System with the purchase of every coin. For a small fee of \$25 you can begin the journey of healing for Indigenous families throughout Canada. This includes shipping anywhere within Canada.
