

First 5 OC releases Request for Information for child care operators

First 5 Orange County is seeking responses to a Request for Information (RFI) to gain a better understanding of the capacity and interest of child care operators interested in working with affordable housing developers.

This RFI is an information gathering tool to help us better facilitate relationships with affordable housing developers for consideration of providing child care services at current and future affordable housing projects.

In order to see if your agency may be suitable for this opportunity, two information sessions have been arranged that will:

- 1. Provide insight into the need for child care services at affordable housing projects;
- 2. Guide potential child care providers/applicants through the process;
- 3. Review the necessary submittal forms; and
- 4. Answer questions regarding the RFI.
