

The complete program includes online and classroom instruction, textbooks, handouts, networking with peers, assistance compiling the Professional Resource Portfolio, independent study and mentorship to prepare for the national certification exam and verification visit.

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Annual Child Care Training Requirements

Family Day Care Provider	 67:42:03:07.02. Training. A family day care provider and helper shall participate in a minimum of six hours of training every year. Three of the six hours of annual training may be from reading sources or televised or video programming. 67:42:10:06. Staff development and training.
Group Family Day Care	Each program must have and implement a written training plan. Each staff member for a group family day care home shall participate in 10 hours of training annually.
Day Care Center	67:42:10:06. Staff development and training. Each program must have and implement a written training plan. Each staff member for a day care center shall participate in 20 hours of training annually.
Out of School Time (OST)	67:42:14:13. Staff training. The center shall have a written plan for training each staff member and volunteer who works directly with children and is included in the staff-child ratio. The staff member or volunteer shall complete 10 hours of training annually.

Staff Orientation	67:42:10:06.01. Staff orientation. The program shall provide for orientation of all staff, and documenta- tion of such, to occur within 90 days after the date of employment. Orientation training may count toward the required annual training for each staff person during the person's first year of employment.
