Thank you for choosing The Right Turn Inc., for your professional development needs. Our team strives to offer a variety of training opportunities, to meet your needs. Please let us know if you are looking for something you can not find here.

Registration:

• You can enroll in classes by emailing bwestergren@therightturn.net or calling 605-773-4755. If you have not already taken a class with us, you will need to fill out the online Registration form and the Release form to allow us to share certificates and training information with your employer. Participants are able to view classes three months at a time, for example in January you will be able to register for classes being held in January, February, and March; in July you will be able to register for classes being held in July, August, and September. Updates, additions or corrections to the catalog will be sent out via email and posted on Facebook. While our office is closed on national and local holidays, any classes scheduled on holidays will be held.

E-Learning Guidelines:

- Participants may not "double-up" on a computer, each participant must log in using their own computer.
- Due to technical difficulties, it is not recommended that you use smart phones or iPads to access online classes.
- To demonstrate participation by sharing in polls,, chats and taking the pre and post tests required in the class.

Private Training at Your Childcare Program

Is there a training topic that your entire staff may benefit from?

 - Does your center have enough adult-sized tables and chairs for all staff? It is easier for staff to focus on class when seated in an adultsized chair.
