Lulu is opening up and learning how to be a dog, but the outside world is still a bit overwhelming. She may take a moment to warm up to a new person, but is quickly won over by gentle scratches. Lulu is very sweet and loves cuddling on the couch, will play with toys, and enjoys a short sniff around the yard. We're slowly introducing the leash. Lulu was

unfamiliar with stairs when she came to us and still needs to be carried down. She is working on going up on her own. When she came in, she didn't seem to have much strength in her rear legs and wouldn't stand for long. Now she has built up her strength and can jump up to the couch on her own. This is her safe space aside from her crate. Lulu has been very clean and quiet in her crate while we are away at work. She gets along well with our two older dogs but is more interested in being with people. We believe she would be happy in a home with another dog showing her the ropes, or could be happy with the attention all to herself. She's a very curious girl and is treat motivated.
