Here come the men in heels! Their mission?

To stomp out sexual violence by walking a mile in her shoes.

Every 7 hours, another Alaskan is sexually assaulted. The most common age of female victims in Alaska is 15, and for male victims it is age 5. (State of Alaska Department of Public Safety 2019 Uniform Crime Report @ https://dps.alaska.gov/statewide/r-i/ucr).

This event calls attention to the fact that sexual violence is widespread and impacts every person in our state. Rape, sexual assault, and sexual harassment harm our community, and statistics show that for too many years, Alaska has had the highest rates of sexual assault in the nation.

STAR is the only agency in Alaska specializing and focusing solely on sexual trauma prevention and response. Whether someone comes forward about a recent trauma or something that happened to them decades earlier, STAR meets them exactly where they are to support them on their healing journey. STAR offers a variety of services that include legal advocacy, court and medical accompaniment, safety planning and emergency assistance (such as emergency relocation, rapid rehousing, protective order application and hearing support), trauma therapy, support groups and art therapy.


