# **GE Trails Task Needs**

## **Composting Privy:**

- Volunteer-adult and child
- Cleaning:
  - Give a thorough sweeping, floors, corners, ceiling, bench, behind toilet, broom should stay in privy, empty trash bag if full and replace, place trash bag in trailhead garbage can
  - Use Clorox wipes (with gloved hands) to wipe toilet seat, sides, and door handles
- Stocking: minimum of 3 tp rolls, large, pump hand sanitizer, Clorox wipes, shaving scoop stays in bucket, trash bags (all cleaning materials will be provided)

### **Clearing Trails:**

- Volunteer-adult and child (with supervision)
  - All year-Walk all trails or trail TBD and remove large obstructive limbs along path, large rocks by throwing to side of trail
  - Spring/Summer-Walk all trails or trail TBD using loppers to cut back invasive silverthorn if grown into trails

#### Trailhead Upkeep and Litter Removal:

- Volunteer-adult and child
  - Using an all purpose spray cleaner and paper towels, wipe from top to bottom the GE Trail map and the History of GE Trails under the kiosk, cleaning until paper towel is free of grime
  - Start along the parking lot adjacent to split-rail fence and trailhead and continue to grassy trailhead picking up trash using gloved hands and (provided) garbage bags.
  - Remove trash embedded in trees and shrubs at the trail perimeter
  - Dispose of trash bags in trailhead garbage can
  - If any items are in the lost and found box, take a picture and send to Julie to post on TRED social media (706 844 8509)
  - Be a set of trail eyes, if anything looks out of place or odd at the trailhead, contact Julie
  - All cleaning materials will be provided

## Bridge/Boardwalk Maintenance:

- Volunteer-adult
  - Locate bridges and boardwalks in need of algae removal
  - Scrub algae with algaecide (will be provided)
  - Apply no skid paint (will be provided)

# Weekly Inspection Ride:

- Volunteer-adult
  - All year in dry weather (except in extremely wet and muddy conditions)
  - Ride all of the trails on a bicycle, taking note of any maintenance needs
    - Needs could include:
      - Noting location of any trail obstruction or hazard
      - Removing fallen logs across trail
      - Areas that need water removal, poison ivy removal, etc.
