Re-Member, Pine Ridge Indian Reservation

The Ogala Lakota Nation define *re-member* as “putting back that which is broken”. Conditions on this South Dakota reservation represent a part of our world that is broken. Since 1998, the nonprofit Re-Member has served these counties with the lowest income in the nation. They aim to improve quality of life on the reservation and to provide opportunities for hundreds of volunteers each year to experience cultural immersion as well as labor. To address the desperate need for housing, volunteers insulate and skirt trailer homes, build bunk beds, wheelchair ramps, and outhouses.

Re-Member challenges volunteers to recall our nation’s treatment of indigenous people and repair that broken relationship through advocacy, in solidarity with the Native American people.
