Materials for Dog Park

Galvanized 5' High chain link fence. Approximately 6500 sq footage-awaiting better measurements once cleared of excess debris

Double Gated for safety
2 separate entrances
Small and large dogs
Possibility of installing a zseparate entrance/exit for small dogs at the front entrance to the small dog area

We will be seeking donations and/or discounts from vendors

Surface Materials

Top Layer 1" light colored rounded pea stone top layer-gentle on paws and easily cleaned off with a hose. Lighter color less apt to be hot in the sun

Ground cover-bottom layer

2" Crushed limestone-good drainage and helps absorb odors

We are fortunate that a few contractors are offering free trucking as a donation

Researching availability of a compressed synthetic material

There are other surfacing options such as decomposed granite, rubber mulch, wood chips and pea gravel.

18 gage steel - 10 gallon Dog waste receptacle with drainage holes
2 in total. For each section

Waste bag stations 2

Signage. Metal on post
