- Everything on campus is designed with our patient's needs in mind





Inpatient Services

Anxiety & Depression Inpatient Program

This unique specialty unit is designed for highly motivated adults who want to engage in treatment and address issues affecting their personal and professional relationships.

Programming is designed for short-term stays of usually no more than seven days. Upon completion, there is an opportunity to step down to our intensive outpatient mental health program (IOP) for continued support.





WHAT WE OFFER

Adult Psychiatric Inpatient Services

In our efforts to provide evidenced-based and acuity-appropriate patient care, we have developed two separate programs for adult patients. Each program is designed to provide a safe, secure environment for the specific needs of each patient.

- Adult Stabilization Unit for patients who are in a severe phase of chronic or persistent mental health illness
- Adult Behavioral Care Unit for patients experiencing acute symptoms related to depression, anxiety, substance abuse, PTSD, trauma, and other behavioral health issues

Mental Health IOP

Offers professional counseling to adults who are medically stable but struggling with depression, anxiety,

or other overwhelming life problems

Monday – Thursday 9 am – 12 pm

2. Chemical Dependency IOP

Provides care to adults who are medically stable after detoxification and may need assistance to maintain abstinence from alcohol or drug use

Monday – Thursday 6 – 9 pm

3. Co-Occurring IOP (New!)

Provides care to adults who are medically stable after detoxification, who need assistance to maintain abstinence from alcohol or drug use and need to address both addiction and mental health disorders with a plan that increases likelihood of recovery from both


