Connecticut's Historic Gardens Day Poster Art Contest 2024

Agreement to Official Rules:

Artists: Entering into this contest constitutes your full and unconditional agreement to and acceptance of these Official Rules and the decisions of Connecticut's Historic Gardens, which are final and binding. Winning is contingent upon fulfilling all requirements set forth herein in a timely manner.

Entry Period: The Connecticut's Historic Gardens Day Poster Contest begins on September 18, 2023 and ends on December 1, 2023 (the "Entry Period".)

Submission Requirements and Process: To enter, complete the online entry form and check the appropriate permission boxes provided. You must include on the entry form your complete and accurate information, including your name, email address, phone and mailing address, title and description of the submitted artwork, and all other information requested. To qualify, your submission must conform to the following specific Contest Rules:

- 1. Each Entry must be a digital copy of an original work (on canvas or otherwise) with oil, acrylic, water color, ink and/or pastel that you have created that does not include material in which a third party has intellectual property rights.
- 2. The work can be created in either portrait or landscape orientation.
- Each Entry must not, in the sole discretion of Connecticut's Historic Gardens, be obscene, indecent, offensive, violent, hateful, or libelous, or contain any other content otherwise inconsistent with the purposes of the Connecticut's Historic Gardens Day Poster Art Contest as described in these Official Rules and related materials.
- 4. Each Entry must be available for poster reproduction at 300 dpi (CMYK) or greater for reproduction purposes.
- 5. IMPORTANT: Each Entry must be submitted for consideration in JPEG format at 300 dpi hi-res (CMYK) format suitable for reproduction, sized no greater than 1024 by 768 pixels and may not exceed 5 MB. Orientation: Portrait or landscape.
- 6. Please do not enter promotional or advertising material into the contest; these will not be accepted.

Artists are allowed to submit up to three original works. The Connecticut's Historic Gardens Day Poster Contest reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to restrict participation in this contest to any person at any time for any reason and/or to disqualify any entry at any time for any reason.

Judging: The artwork will be judged by a jury of members of Connecticut's Historic Gardens Group. Entries are judged between December 4 and December 11, 2023. The winning artist will be notified by December 13, 2023 and the prize will be awarded by January 26, 2024, once the final image of the artwork has been submitted. All decisions of the jury are final.
