


#### SPEAKER | GAEL O'SULLIVAN

Gael O'Sullivan is a longtime friend of Maryanne Shanahan whose more than 30-year career in international development has taken her around the globe. She has worked in 42 countries in Africa, the Middle East, Europe, Asia, and the Caribbean. Gael lived at length in Switzerland and in Togo. She received her bachelor of science degree at Georgetown University and was awarded an MBA in International Marketing at George Washington University. Gael is Adjunct Professor, Social Marketing for Global Good, at Georgetown University, McDonough School of Business. She is fluent in French.

Gael will share some key concepts from behavioral science that explain why we behave the way we do, with a focus on health behaviors. Gael also will share real-world examples from her work around the world and from the published literature. Whatever our age, behavioral change to improve our health and welfare or financial circumstance and the environment--is not out of reach. Understanding the science behind such change may help us get there!




