Newlin 1st grade teachers meet with Newlin Literacy Project Steering Committee to share feedback

On Tuesday, May 6th, the Newlin Literacy Project steering committee had an opportunity to meet with the first grade teachers, Principal Will Price, and Newlin Literacy Coach Brittney Moody, to review this past year of tutoring and share feedback as the end of the year approaches. From October through May, fourteen tutors met twice weekly with their students to help them become good readers.

When asked about the impact of the NLP tutoring program on their students, teachers said that students increased in their confidence. Teachers reported that when students get tutored, they realize they CAN decode words or recognize letters. So, in addition to learning reading skills, they are gaining confidence and motivation to continue learning.


