- (3) Review of Propositions / Vision & Value Statements (changes from previous wording highlighted in red):
 - a. Maintain the current rations of land use within the area. When possible, increase the ratio of single-family residential land use.

 - Area.
 - b. Generally disapprove of land use changes requiring rezoning if currently available properties with the required zoning exist in the general area."
 - c. Preserve and increase the amount of green and recreational spaces.
 - d. [Detached from item c]: Increase the amount of tree canopy through the area focusing on the use of native tree species.
 - Mr. Weber discussed introducing to the Commission applying to become a Greenspot Neighborhood.
 - e. Improve pedestrian access and safety by connecting areas with multi-use paths and sidewalks, and improve the access to public transportation.
 - f. [Detached from item e]: WSAC strongly encourages developments that bring essential regional services to accommodate the area's current and future residents.
- (4) Discussion on identifying plots of land that are ripe for redevelopment and improvement and locations where essential services (such as a recreation center or grocery store) could be located.
