Current Business:

BZA20-122 (2080 Arlingate Lane):

- The applicant would like to get a variance for a perimeter sidewalk to preserve the trees in the area. They also want to keep the trees and brush because it acts as a natural barrier.
- The building has already been properly zoned.
- In the area there are no current sidewalks. Their plan would require the sidewalk to flank the building.
- It is estimated that there will be almost 1,000 feet of sidewalk put in the area.
- They are required to have a front sidewalk, however the applicant asks that they do not install a connector sidewalk to ensure the safety of their patients.
- Their staff are required to have a car, so they are not going to be using the bus stop on Trabue Road.
