LuAnn Dunkinson invites you to sketch along with her as she shares some of her experience and techniques from one of her two of her favorite pastimes - Plein Aire Painting and Urban Sketching.



"For our demo, we will be sketching from a photo and I will be using pen and ink with watercolor washes. I encourage you to sketch along! If you are planning to do this, please bring these simple materials:

- A small sketchbook (I usually use a Canson 10" x 7" when sketching out). If using watercolor washes, you will be more successful if its watercolor friendly paper.
- Waterproof pens, you can use any you like- Microns are good, or any fountain pens you like. I use a Duke 550, with a fude nib).
- A small travel watercolor set with a brush and a small water container." (optional) - full-size reference photo on website

LuAnn is the President of the Jacksonville Watercolor Society, after serving several years on the Board. She is also an active member of the First Coast Plein Aire Painters, Florida Watercolor Society, Jacksonville Artist Guild, St Augustine Art Association, and the Jacksonville Urban Sketchers. She's won numerous awards for her watercolors, most notably The Cheap Joes Purchase Award at the Florida Watercolor Society's 50Th Anniversary Show in 2021. There have also been several awards in Plein Aire painting, including the First Place Blue Ribbon at the St Mary's Plein Aire Competition in 2022 and 2023. <u>Link to LuAnn's website.</u>


2024 ONE-DAY WORKSHOP—Still a few spaces available!

In this workshop we'll explore simplifying a portrait into its basic components. We'll use techniques such as feathering, lifting, wetintowet, lost and found edges, and more. We'll discuss how to use a reference photo to achieve the results we want, and improve our portrait painting skills to be able to capture our loved ones in watercolor. Every step will be clearly



demoed as we move through the workshop. Most of all, come have fun and expand your abilities.

Ted's work has been published in American Artist magazine, SPLASH 11 and SPLASH 16, the Best of America Watercolor Artists & Artisans. He has also won over 85 awards, including dozens of "Best of" and 1st place awards, and has become a popular workshop instructor and show judge. Ted believes that when his brush dances between imagination and reality, something magical can happen. When it does, the emotional connection between him and his subject says it all. Design, values and color are the means to express a moment in

time, captured in dramatic watercolor or oils. An avid kayaker, his paintings show a fascination with light and color, depicting nature's beauty, wildlife, pets, and people, especially his grandkids.

MEMBERS' SPRING NON-JURIED SHOW MARCH 1-26, 2024 CYPRESS VILLAGE, EGRET HALL MARCH 10 RECEPTION 2-3 PM

JWS Members have been invited to participate in an exhibition at Cypress Village, Egret Hall for the month of March. Paintings may be for sale and no commission will be charged. All sales will be handled directly with the artists. There will be a reception at Cypress Village on Sunday, March 10, from 2-3 pm. There will be refreshments. No awards will be given.

Since this is a non-juried show, we will be a little more lenient with regard to framing rules however, all submissions must be done in an aqueous manner, according to JWS rules for acceptable medium and surfaces. Frames can be any color and material and should be in good condition, but still must use plexi-glass, NO glass. Be sure the wire hanger is secured on each side of the frame, no fixed metal hangers. Mats, if used, should be clean and fit the painting and frame with no gaps. There will not be a size restriction other than the normal rule which limits the size to a maximum of 44". We will disregard the minimum frame size for now.

Submissions will be done on-line through our website from Feb 19th through the 26th. There will be no fee to enter. Paintings entered are not disqualified from entry in the Fall show. To include your painting in this Members Show, please go to the website.

Take-in will be on Friday, March 1, from 10:00 am to 12:00, at Cypress Village, Egret Hall, tower A, however we will start hanging the show as paintings are brought in. We have a short time frame to get everything in and hung so the earlier you can get your submissions in the better. I also encourage you to carpool or use a drop-off site due to parking limitations during the day. If you plan to drop-off your painting with a site volunteer, please be sure to call first to arrange a convenient time for both of you.
