


NOVEMBER GUEST ARTIST: PABLO RIVERA

ZOOM is a web-based video conferencing tool that allows users to meet online, with or without video on your device: phone, Ipad, laptop or computer. During the current Pandemic environment, it has been a lifesaver for organizations, business and education. Understanding that **ZOOM** .may be new to some of our members, we will continue to provide simple, yet precise instructions on "How to **ZOOM!**"

Before joining a ZOOM meeting on a computer or mobile device, you can download the ZOOM app from
the app store. Or, your browser may take you right to the meeting. Otherwise, you may be prompted to
download and install ZOOM when you click on the join link which will be provided in an email to
members from Chris Olmoguez, or Barbara Holt before the day of the meeting.


Because we will still maintain social distancing, attendance will be limited to 15 participants. Each participant will have their own 6 foot table and will wear a mask.
