Looking for lots of color and dramatic light, Robin's vibrant watercolors are painted in her studio from her own original photography and still life set ups. She works in series and while no subject is favored, her most popular series are her tropical and desert florals, and her Happy Hour series, now with its 50th painting in the works. She works both on paper and Aquabord, which requires varnish sealant but does not require mats or reflective glazing that can distract from the image.

She currently serves as Director of Communications for the Florida Watercolor Society and served as Exhibition Director from late 2015 – 2021. In addition to many tasks and projects throughout the year, Robin produces the newsletters for FWS, created the 2022 Annual Exhibition catalog, and other graphics needs.

Robin has conceived, curated, organized, and produced many themed art shows in her own New Mexico gallery, for organizations, and for the Elliott Museum in Stuart, FL, where she had the position of Art Studio & Exhibition Coordinator from 2012 until 2020. She has served as judge of selection and/or juror of awards for many art festivals and juried art shows.
