Make sure to see the special exhibit by Virginia Meadows, Artist of the Year for 2021 in Westbury Parish Hall, running concurrent with the Fall Show.
- JWS Awards will be announced during our opening reception on Saturday, October 29 at Christ Episcopal Church, Westbury Parish Hall from 1 pm to 3 pm. Wine and snacks will be served. Artist of the Year for 2022 will also be announced during the reception.
- Take-down and pickup is on Monday, November 28 from 10 am to 1 pm; go to Westbury Parish Hall. As always, if you are unable to pick up your work, please contact a JWS friend who can help!

Directions: From A1A, turn east onto Solana Rd at the light, then turn left onto San Juan Dr and follow it around to the Church Parking Entrance sign and park in the parking garage/deck. Westbury Parish Hall is on the left when you exit the parking deck. Walk through the portico between Westbury Parish Hall and Blacker Hall buildings and into the courtyard between the Westbury Parish Hall and the Formation & Arts buildings. Turn left in front of Westbury Parish Hall and the left. They should be open during normal operating hours; please call if you have any questions about hours.
