As a senior with limited funding, he was beside himself that his mode of transportation was taken from him. In response, the Freedom Centre put a Facebook ad out asking for a donation of a bike. Within a couple of hours, the bike was offered and the next



evening it was delivered. The friend was so taken aback by the kindness of people, which had been challenged so many times in his life, he offered to come and help at our Community Neighbourhood Table! Thank you for the kindness of others we were able to get him a bicycle and renew his belief in humanity!

Knowing veterans are sleeping in their cars is a mind blowing and heart wrenching reality in our region.

"August 9 was selected as National Peacekeeper's Day in 2008, to recognize the greatest single-day loss of Canadian lives on a peacekeeping mission, which occurred on this day in 1974, when a Canadian military transport aircraft was shot down by Syrian missiles during a regular resupply mission in the Middle East, claiming the lives of nine Canadian peacekeepers."
