

### *Walking Routes*



**02 MILL GLEN**, Tillicoultry, an exciting short walk exploring the dramatic Glen  
**2km/1.25miles - Moderate**

**03 JUBILEE WALK** can be enjoyed end-to-end or a section at a time

**21km/13miles - Easy**

**01 DUMYAT** superb position on the fringe of the Ochils overlooking the Wee County

Via Hill Path:

**7.5km/4.75 miles –**

**Moderate**

From Blairlogie:

**6km/3.75miles - Hard**

Did you know that Dumyat was the capital of a lost Iron Age people?



**04 ALVA GLEN** this short walk follows a dramatic path which climbs deep into the ravine containing 5 waterfalls

**2.5km/1.5miles - Moderate**

**05 OCHILS WOODLAND PARK**, Alva, an attractive woodland park that cuts through some of our finest scenery

**06 DOLLAR GLEN** a spectacular walk with the Castle Campbell at the top  
**3.25km/2miles - Moderate**

**07 BLACK DEVON WETLANDS**, Alloa, is a mosaic of untouched grassland & wetland habitat

**08 GARTMORN DAM** is at the heart of a 370 acre Country Park and Nature Reserve, perfect for walking and cycling
