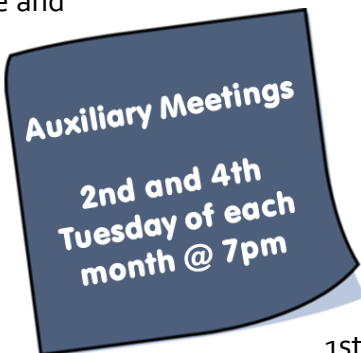
Cindy Jones has agreed to chair our next meet and greet. It was so nice to meet some of you sisters at the last one and hope you will come again.

VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT – CLARINE WATKINS

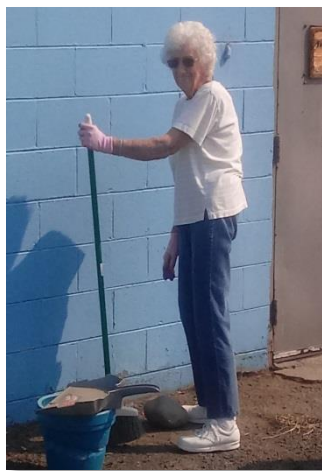
