Ordinance No. 51 2020

**ORDINANCE AMENDING DESIGNATED LOCATIONS WITHIN
THE CITY OF NORWOOD FOR THE POSTING OF ORDINANCES,
RESOLUTIONS, STATEMENTS, ORDERS, PROCLAMATIONS,
NOTICES AND REPORTS REQUIRED BY LAW,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, in limited circumstances, Ohio Revised Code Section 731.25 permits the publication of ordinances and resolutions by posting in public places within the City of Norwood; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish the purpose of ORC Section 731.25, the Council passed Ordinance 12-2011 on March 8, 2011 and codified that ordinance as Norwood Codified Ordinance Section 123.01; and

WHEREAS, since the enactment of Ordinance 12-2011 and Norwood Codified Ordinance Section 123.01, the Norwood Service League is no longer operating at 2071 Lawrence Avenue, and the City of Norwood has developed two new on-line locations for the publication of documents by the City of Norwood; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:


SECTION 1. Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 731.25, the following places are hereby designated the locations for the posting of ordinances, resolutions, statements, orders, proclamations, notices and reports, as required by law:

- (1) Norwood City Hall 4645 Montgomery Road
- (2) Norwood Community Center 1810 Courtland Avenue
- (3) Norwood City Health Department 2059 Sherman Avenue
- (4) Norwood City School Administration Building 2132 Williams Avenue
- (5) Norwood Branch of Public Library 4325 Montgomery Road
- (6) City of Norwood Website-news page (<https://norwoodohio.gov/news>)
- (7) City of Norwood Facebook page: @NorwoodOhio.Gov (<https://www.facebook.com/NorwoodOhio.Gov/>)

SECTION 2. Such postings shall be for a period of not less than fifteen days prior to the effective date of the ordinance or resolution.




