

Ordinance No. 2019

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ACCEPT PROPOSAL AND ENTER INTO A LEASE AGREEMENT, UNDER STATE BID PURCHASE PROGRAM, WITH MILLENNIUM BUSINESS SYSTEMS FOR THE LEASE OF PRINTERS FOR THE CITY OF NORWOOD POLICE DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN **EMERGENCY** 

WHEREAS, Norwood City Council desires to lease reliable printers for use by the Norwood Police Department, thereby replacing the current lease agreement at a lower cost; now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to enter into a lease agreement, under the State Bid Purchase Program, with Millennium Business Systems in accordance with specifications on file in the office of the Service-Safety Director for the lease of printers, for the Norwood Police Department and to sign the proposal as listed in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw, and the City Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay, warrants in the amounts specified in the contract for sixty (60) months for the foregoing purpose out of the GENERAL FUND,

SECTION 3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the inhabitants of the City of Norwood, due to current favorable contract terms and the immediate need to preserve pricing, and shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
