Ordinance No. 13 20 20

**ORDINANCE CONSENTING TO THE PROJECT ID NO. 109334,
BRIDGE INSPECTION MAINTENANCE SERVICES,
AS DESCRIBED IN THE ATTACHED CONSULTANT'S SCOPE
OF SERVICES TASK ORDER CONTRACT (EXHIBIT A),
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio has offered to provide Bridge Inspection Program Services to the City of Norwood, as a Local Public Agency (LPA), under Project ID No. 109334, including, but not limited to, bridge load rating calculations, scour assessments, bridge inspections, and fracture critical plan development; and the City of Norwood has determined that the provision of these services is in the interest of public safety; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. Project ID No. 109334 being in the interest of public safety, the City of Norwood, the Local Public Agency (LPA) gives consent to the Director of Transportation for the State of Ohio to complete the above described project, which will include the following City of Norwood bridges:

Structure File Number 3164470 (Section Avenue over CSX Railroad);
Structure File Number 3160009 (Harris Avenue over Duck Creek); and
Structure File Number 3160011 (Wesley Avenue over CSX Railroad), and may include any span of combined sewer system going under City streets which is ten (10) feet or more in span length, as the State of Ohio considers all such street crossings as municipal bridges.

SECTION 2. The City of Norwood shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation for the State of Ohio in the above described project as follows: The State of Ohio shall assume and bear one hundred percent (100%) of all the cost for Bridge Inspection Program Services requested by the City and agreed to by the State of Ohio. Eligible Bridge Inspection Services are described in the Consultant's Scope of Services Task Order Contract, attached as Exhibit A. The City of Norwood as the LPA agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features which are not included in the attached Exhibit A.

SECTION 3. The City of Norwood as the LPA agrees that all rights-of-ways required for the described project will be made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations.

SECTION 4. The City of Norwood hereby authorizes and empowers its Safety-Service Director, on behalf of the City of Norwood as LPA, to enter into contracts with the State of Ohio's Director of Transportation which are necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION 5. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary to expedite this bridge inspection program and to promote bridge safety and the welfare of the community and shall take effect immediately upon adoption.


