ORDINANCE ALLOWING FOR CITY EMPLOYEES TO RECEIVE A ONE-TIME PANDEMIC ESSENTIAL SUPPORT PAYOUT FOR SERVICES RENDERED IN 2020 DURING THE PANDEMIC, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Council and the City Administration wish to recognize the critically important care that the City received during and after the pandemic that crippled the nation in 2020; and

WHEREAS, the "MISSION CRITICAL" support that was provided to the community never stopped, twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week, all year long; and

WHEREAS, while others had the ability to quarantine to minimize the potential of exposure to themselves and their families, the City's Essential Service providers have not been provided these options or protections, and

WHEREAS, it is recognized that our full-time City employees continued to serve the community to the fullest of their abilities and exceeded expectations on every level; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio:

SECTION 1. Each current full-time employee who worked through the full calendar year of 2020 will receive a one-time Pandemic Essential Support Provider payout.

SECTION 2. Full-time City employees that keep the city infrastructure, water utility and other essential departments operational will receive one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) in recognition of the services provided.

SECTION 3. Full-time members of the Fire Department and Police Department who provided care and transported potential COVID 19 carriers will receive a payout of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.00) in recognition of the services provided.

SECTION 4. Only current employees who were employed by the City for all twelve (12) months of 2020 are eligible to receive this Pandemic Essential Support Payout.

SECTION 5. Only current employees in good standing at the time this ordinance is passed, are eligible for this Pandemic Essential Support Payout.

SECTION 6. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay the foregoing from fund **2096 Norwood Corona Virus Relief.**

SECTION 7. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare, and shall go into effect forthwith.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY AUDITOR TO APPROVE A "THEN AND NOW" CERTIFICATE FROM THE WATER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS FUND (5050-0853-57600) TO COVER THE COST OF THE FINAL INVOICE FROM THE GREATER CINCINNATI WATER WORKS, FOR THE NORWOOD WATER SYSTEM ANALYSIS PROJECT, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$62,561.56, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City Auditor has requested that the Council authorize the Auditor to approve a "Then and Now" certificate for 2021, not to exceed \$62,561.56, from the Water Capital Improvements Fund (5050-0853-57600) to cover the cost of the final invoice, Invoice #2, for Greater Cincinnati Water Works, which provided services from February 1, 2021 through project completion; and

WHEREAS, the final invoice from Greater Cincinnati Water Works for 2021 services was not submitted to the City Auditor until on or after October 26, 2021, so no purchase order was signed, and the "not to exceed" amount of \$62,561.56 exceeds the \$2,500.00 limit for which the City Auditor can approve "Then and Now" certificates, without this Council's approval; and

WHEREAS, the City has received Final Invoice – Invoice #2, from Greater Cincinnati Water Works for \$62,561.56; and

WHEREAS, in order to pay Invoice #2 from Greater Cincinnati Water Works, the City has deemed it to be beneficial for the City of Norwood to have a "Then and Now" certificate authorized by a resolution of the Council; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Auditor's office is hereby authorized to approve a "Then and Now" certificate for 2021 in amounts not to exceed \$62,561.56 from the **Water Capital Improvement Fund (5050-0853-57600)** to cover the cost of the Final Invoice—Invoice #2 from Greater Cincinnati Water Works for the Norwood Water System Analysis Project.

SECTION 2. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency resolution and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to proceed forthwith to authorize payment of the final invoice from Greater Cincinnati Water Works.
