Ordinance No. 37 20 20

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY-SERVICE OR THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF CINCINNATI TO PURCHASE A 2009 ROSENBAUER LADDER FIRE TRUCK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood Fire Department needs to replace the 1996 ladder fire truck which, on May 22, 2020, suffered a mechanical failure while responding to a reported fire, and which truck has been examined by mechanical service provider Clarke Power Systems. The Fire Department has received a quote of \$3,900.00 to trailer the 1996 ladder fire truck to Clarke Power Systems in Henderson, Kentucky, just to get a quote to rebuild its engine. Clarke Power Systems has also estimated the cost to the City of Norwood to install a new engine in the 1996 ladder fire truck is \$49,650.60.

WHEREAS, Norwood's Fire Chief has made arrangements with the City of Cincinnati, Ohio for the City of Norwood to purchase a 2009 Rosenbauer ladder fire truck for \$80,000.00 (as authorized by Ohio Revised Code §753.05 which authorizes a legislative authority of any city to ordain that the Director of Public Service-Safety or the Mayor of the City of Norwood purchase equipment from another political subdivision without bidding); now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:


SECTION 1. The Safety-Service Director is authorized to enter into a contract with the City of Cincinnati, Ohio to purchase a 2009 Rosenbauer ladder fire truck from the City of Cincinnati for \$80,000.00.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is authorized to draw, and the City Treasurer is authorized to pay \$80,000.00 for the 2019 Rosenbauer ladder fire truck out of the GENERAL FUND 01.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. There is a specific need for the Fire Department to properly protect people and property in the City from fire damage; and to provide the City's professional fire fighters with the fire suppression equipment which they need to provide this fire safety by placing this ladder fire truck into service by approximately June 15, 2020.


