Ordinance No. 33 2019

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO ADVERTISE FOR BIDS AND ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR HIGHLAND AVENUE REPAVING FROM ASH STREET TO THE CINCINNATI CORPORATION LINE, WITHIN THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council desires to help the City of Norwood benefit from outside funding to repave Highland Avenue from Ash Street to the Cincinnati Corporation line, including approximately \$120,000.00 from a Municipal Road Fund (MRF) grant, and approximately \$300,000.00 from a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), approximately \$680,000.00 worth of road work, (approximately 4,200 linear feet) for approximately \$260,000 contributed by the City, which must be done in 2019, or the City of Norwood will lose approximately \$420,000 in grant money; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Service-Safety Director is hereby authorized to advertise for bids and enter into a contract for the Highland Avenue Repaving Project, pursuant to plans and specifications on file in the office of the Service-Safety Director.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay warrants for the foregoing purpose out of FUND 02-0852-57600 STREET CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to implement a roadway improvement project that improves the health and safety of the City of Norwood by benefitting from about \$420,000.00 in grant money which must be expended in 2019.
