**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE MONTH OF OCTOBER 2020 TO BE
"BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH"
IN THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO**

WHEREAS, this year approximately 276,480 new cases of invasive breast cancer will be diagnosed in the United States, and roughly 42,170 people will die from this disease; and

WHEREAS, in Ohio an estimated 10,350 new cases will be diagnosed and an estimated 1,710 people will die from this disease in 2020; and

WHEREAS, having a mother, sister, or daughter with breast cancer almost doubles a woman's risk of contracting this disease. Women with a father or brother who has had breast cancer also have a higher risk of breast cancer; overall, about 15% of women with breast cancer have a family member with this disease; and

WHEREAS, breast cancer is the second leading cause of cancer in women in the United States America, in which only lung cancer kills more; and

WHEREAS, the average risk of a woman in the United States developing breast cancer sometime in her life is 13% or a 1 in 8 chance; and

WHEREAS, education about breast cancer and early detection strategies are critical to saving lives and protecting our families. The economic hardship it causes families is huge: in 2010 the cost of treating breast cancer was \$16.5 billion higher than any other type of cancer. This was expected to increase to \$20.5 billion by 2020; and


WHEREAS, there are more than 3.5 million breast cancer survivors in the United States, including women still receiving treatment, and

WHEREAS, because all women and men are at risk of developing breast cancer, we encourage citizens of Norwood to recognize the importance of breast cancer screening; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:


