Ordinance No. 8 2020

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT WITH HAMILTON COUNTY, OHIO TO PROVIDE ITS SERVICES IN DISPOSING OF CITY SURPLUS PERSONAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, The City of Norwood has statutory authority under R.C. § 721.15 to dispose of personal property found by the Council to be unneeded, obsolete or unfit ("Surplus") for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, R.C. § 9.482 authorizes the City of Norwood to contract with another political subdivision to render any service or perform any function which the City of Norwood is authorized by law to perform; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Services Division of Hamilton County, Ohio provides services to other political subdivisions in Hamilton County in auctioning government Surplus personal property; and

WHEREAS, Hamilton County, Ohio has proposed that the City of Norwood enter into a contract to allow Hamilton County to dispose of personal property which the City of Norwood determines to be Surplus property through Hamilton County's Internet Surplus Auction web address: www.HamiltonCountyOhioAuction.com; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration recommends contracting with Hamilton County to use Hamilton County's services, which will allow the City to utilize the services of Hamilton County, which will be much more efficient, and provide a broader bidding audience, for the proper disposition of the City's Surplus property.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio:


SECTION 1. The Safety Service Director and Mayor are authorized to execute the Contract with Hamilton County, Ohio, attached as Exhibit 1, to provide auction services to the City to dispose of such personal property as the City deems to be Surplus personal property.

SECTION 2. By separate Resolution, Council, upon recommendation of the Administration, shall declare property to be Surplus and authorize the disposition of such Surplus property, consistent with the terms of the Contract through Hamilton County, Ohio. Any proceeds received by the City from the sales shall be deposited to the General Fund.

SECTION 3. In inventorying property which the Administration deems to be Surplus, any property which the Administration determines to be obsolete or unfit for use for which it was acquired and has no value, may be discarded, appropriately salvaged, or may be donated to any public agencies, non-profit or charitable organizations servicing the City of Norwood community.


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest time allowed by law.


