



Ordinance No. 31 20 18

**ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR TO APPROVE "THEN AND NOW" CERTIFICATES FOR THE WATER FUND (50) TO COVER THE COST OF INVOICES FOR THE GREATER CINCINNATI WATER WORKS FOR 2018 UP TO \$550,000, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, the City Auditor has requested that the Council authorize the Auditor to approve "Then and Now" certificates for 2018 up to \$550,000.00 for The Water Fund (50) to cover the cost of invoices for the Greater Cincinnati Water Works; and

WHEREAS, at a public meeting, the Council's Finance Committee has considered and recommended approval of the Auditor's request; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The City Auditor's office is hereby authorized to approve "Then and Now" certificates for 2018 totaling up to \$550,00.00 for **THE WATER FUND (50)** to cover the cost of invoices for the Greater Cincinnati Water Works. These certificates shall state that both at the time the contract was made or the purchase order issued (then) and at the time the certificate is executed (now), the amount of the order or contract has been lawfully appropriated for the purpose of the order or contract, that the appropriation remains unencumbered and that resources to pay the obligation when it comes due are on hand or in the process of collection to the credit of **THE WATER FUND (50)**.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to proceed forthwith to authorize payment of invoices for the Greater Cincinnati Water Works for 2018 to avoid incurring any late fees on those payments.
