*Ordinance No.* 34 *20* 20

**AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND SAFETY-SERVICE DIRECTOR TO SIGN AN AMENDMENT WITH DYNEGY ENERGY SERVICES (EAST) LLC TO EXTEND THE GOVERNMENTAL ELECTRIC POWER AGGREGATION FROM JUNE 2021 TO JUNE 2022 FOR A "TRADITIONAL" ENERGY AGGREGATION PRODUCT NOT TO EXCEED THE PRICE OF 5.09¢ PER KILOWATT HOUR (kWh), AND AN ADDITIONAL CUSTOMER OPT-IN "RENEWABLE" ENERGY AGGREGATION PRODUCT NOT TO EXCEED THE PRICE OF 5.29¢ PER KILOWATT HOUR (kWh), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, by Ordinance 11-2017 Norwood City Council developed an Electric Aggregation Program Plan of Operation and Governance ("Plan of Operation") in accordance with the governmental aggregation provisions of Sections 4901 and 4928.20 of the Ohio Revised Code and the Rules for Formation and Operation of Electric Governmental Aggregations; and

**WHEREAS**, since that time, the City of Norwood's electric aggregation program has aggregated the retail electric load of residents and businesses that are eligible to participate in the Duke Energy-Ohio Energy Choice program for the purpose of negotiating for competitive retail electric supply at favorable rates; and

**WHEREAS**, since that time, the City of Norwood has filed for certification as a Governmental Aggregator, which required that the City Council first adopt its Plan of Operation and Governance; and

**WHEREAS**, the Norwood City Council determined that Ordinance 11-2017 was in the best interest of the City's residents, and promoted the general welfare of said citizenry;


**WHEREAS**, in light of current market conditions, Energy Alliances, the City of Norwood's Energy Consulting advisors, recommends that the City of Norwood enter into an Amendment with Dynegy Energy Services (East) LLC to extend the governmental electric power aggregation from June 2021 to June 2022 for a "traditional" energy aggregation product not to exceed the price of 5.09¢ per kilowatt hour (kWh), and an additional customer opt-in "renewable" energy aggregation product, not to exceed the price of 5.29¢ per kilowatt hour (kWh); now therefore,

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWOOD, HAMILTON COUNTY, STATE OF OHIO:**

**SECTION 1.** This Council authorizes the Mayor and the Safety-Service Director to sign an Amendment with Dynegy Energy Services (East) LLC to extend the governmental electric power aggregation from June 2021 to June 2022 for a "traditional" energy aggregation product not to exceed the price of 5.09¢ per kilowatt hour (kWh), and an additional customer opt-in "renewable" energy aggregation product not to exceed the price of 5.29¢ per kilowatt hour (kWh) as attached hereto (see Exhibit A).


**SECTION 2.** This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to proceed to enter into the Amendment for an electric power commodity which is subject to frequent price changes, and to save both the City of Norwood and other residential and business customers who are eligible to participate in the electric power cost savings allowed through this Amendment.




