Ordinance No. 18 20 20

ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE SAFETY SERVICE DIRECTOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE EMERGENCY REPAIR OF THE STORM SEWER RUNNING NORTH TO SOUTH IN THE AREA SOUTH OF NORWOOD AVENUE AND NORTH OF STATE ROUTE 562 NEAR LINDEN AVENUE (BEHIND THE PET SPOT), WITHIN THE CITY OF NORWOOD, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Norwood's consulting engineers have determined the need to repair the deterioration of the storm sewer running north to south in the area south of Norwood Avenue and north of State Route 562 near Linden Avenue, behind the Pet Spot pet care business, to be a real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation and maintenance of the department of public service, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code section 735.051 which governs public contracts for repairs, under which emergency conditions obviate the need for formal bidding and advertising for contracts upon a two-thirds affirmative vote of all the members of this Council; and

WHEREAS, given the exigent circumstances of the emergent need to repair this deteriorating storm sewer to avoid further water damage to the public infrastructure and private business under which the City of Norwood's storm sewer runs, the City consulting engineers have informally solicited bids from various reputable infrastructure repair contractors and have received bids from at least two of those contractors; and

WHEREAS, the City Administration has recommended that the Council follow the City's consulting engineer's advice to get the storm sewer and the area immediately surrounding it repaired forthwith, to avoid further deterioration of the storm sewer and damage, including erosion to the surrounding area; now therefore,


BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Norwood, State of Ohio, that:

SECTION 1. The Safety Service Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for emergency repairs of the storm sewer running north to south in the area south of Norwood Avenue and north of State Route 562 near Linden Avenue, behind the Pet Spot pursuant to plans and specifications on file in the office of the Safety Service Director.

SECTION 2. The City Auditor is hereby authorized to draw and the City Treasurer to pay warrants for the foregoing purpose out of the GENERAL FUND 01.


SECTION 3. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and a measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall go into effect forthwith. The reason for said emergency is the necessity to rapidly repair the storm sewer and the surrounding earthen works to eliminate the possibility of further deterioration of either public or private property at the location of the storm sewer.


