## ORDINATION AND NEW MINISTRY OF THE REV. CORY MICHAEL IRWIN




THE KENT MANSION ART GALLERY



There will be volunteer opportunities for anyone who is interested in being involved in this year's General Convention. If you would like more information, see Fr. Allan.




