

ST. PAUL'S PET FOOD PANTRY




Please help us restock our shelves for the monthly Pet Food Pantry. The

STATIONS OF THE CROSS

March 1- April 5

Starting Wednesday, March 1, we will be offering Stations of the Cross at 5:30pm in the church followed by a Soup dinner in the Parish House Parlor. Each week will be slightly different, so that you can experience the liturgy from different lenses.

March 1: Traditional Way of the Cross
March 8: "Everyone's" Way of the Cross
March 15: Today's Stations of the Cross
March 22: "We Were There"
March 29: Chanted Way of the Cross

We hope you will join us for these prayers and reflections and stay to enjoy fellowship in the Parish House Parlor. There is a sign-up sheet below and in the Carriage House if you would like to bring soups and/or bread, otherwise come and enjoy great company.



Following each week's Stations of the Cross, there will be a "Souper Supper" in the Parish House Parlor. Two soups and bread will be offered (including a vegetarian option). The suppers will conclude in time for choir members to get to their 7 pm rehearsal in the church.

10am - Penitential service with Holy Eucharist that includes music, singing, and the St. Paul's choir.


